Consigners or their servants must remain in charge of their respective lots, give assistance to and from the rings and truck if required - the stock being at consigners risk until taken delivery of, and settlement of sales cannot be made until the stock is delivered to the buyers.

All sheep and ram lambs are guaranteed correct in mouth on day of sale.

All complaints regarding incorrect mouths must be lodged along with £5 at Main Office any time after purchase but not later than half an hour after the conclusion of the sale. The fee of £5 will be refunded if buyer's appeal is upheld. The appointed arbiters' decision is final.

All rams and ram lambs are warranted by the vendor to be capable of and effective at natural service. If any such ram has proved to be incapable of or ineffective at natural service and written notice to that effect is given to the Auctioneers within 10 weeks after the date of sale then, after proof, the purchaser may return the ram to the vendor who shall refund the purchase price of the animal together with costs of transport and veterinary expenses. No claim for consequential loss will be entertained.

No riggs will be sold.

If the total entry of shearlings for October 2019 exceeds **600** head, a second ring will be balloted and sold at the conclusion of the ram lamb sale. The second ring will be drawn from the 2018 bottommost averages and will include all new consignments and those without a relevant average. A minimum of **four** sheep or more must be sold through the ring to classify as a relevant average.
